Top 100 Senior High School Rankings: National Science And Maths Quiz (NSMQ)

The 2025 *EN Analytics* Top 100 Senior High School Rankings for the National Science and Maths Quiz (NSMQ) competition is based on comprehensive data drawn from 260 senior high schools across the sixteen regions of Ghana. Over the years, this ranking has earned a strong reputation for credibility and methodological rigor. It is widely accepted and trusted by students, teachers, educational institutions, and the general public, and has become the gold standard and the primary reference for students seeking admission to secondary education in Ghana.

A school's position in the rankings is determined by four key parameters: (i) the final stage reached at the national level in the current competition year; (ii) the school's placement in its final contest at the national level; (iii) the category assigned to the school by the Ghana Education Service; and (iv) the school's historical performance in the NSMQ between 2013 and 2024.

The NSMQ remains one of Ghana's most respected academic platforms, showcasing the intellectual depth, discipline, and analytical strength of the nation's brightest students. It provides a robust basis for evaluating and comparing schools, as it assesses not only proficiency in mathematics and science, but also critical thinking, teamwork, innovation, and the ability to solve complex problems under time pressure.

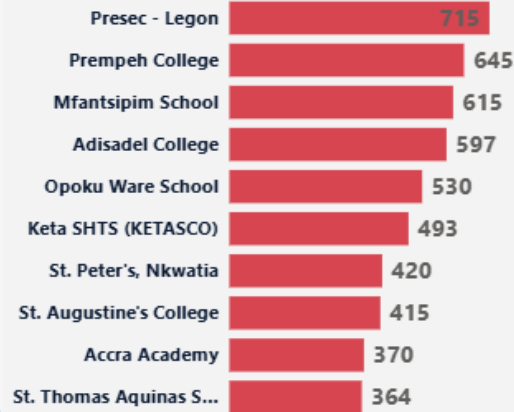

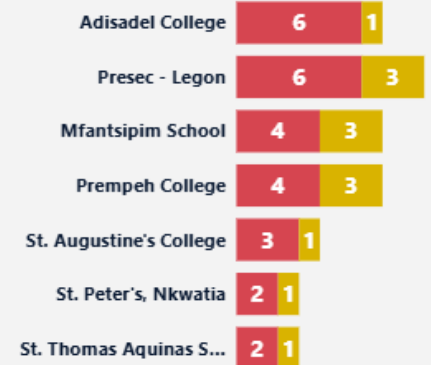

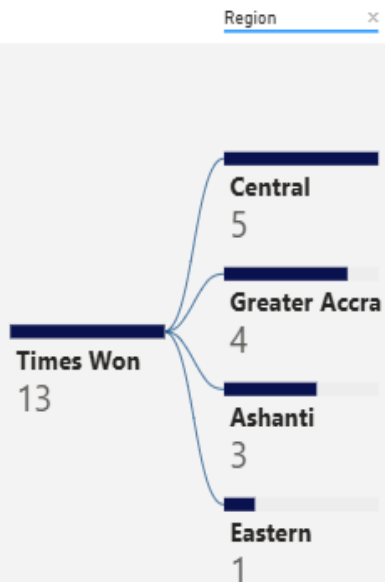

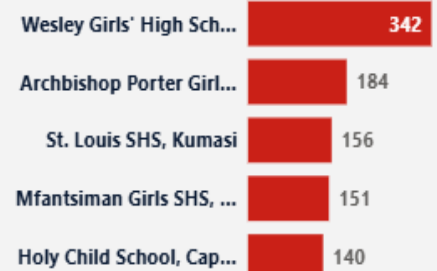

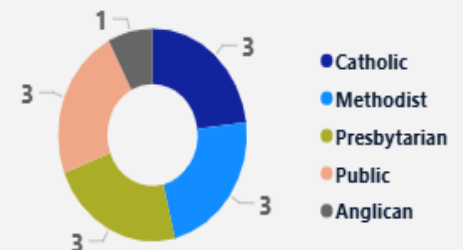
Winning by Region



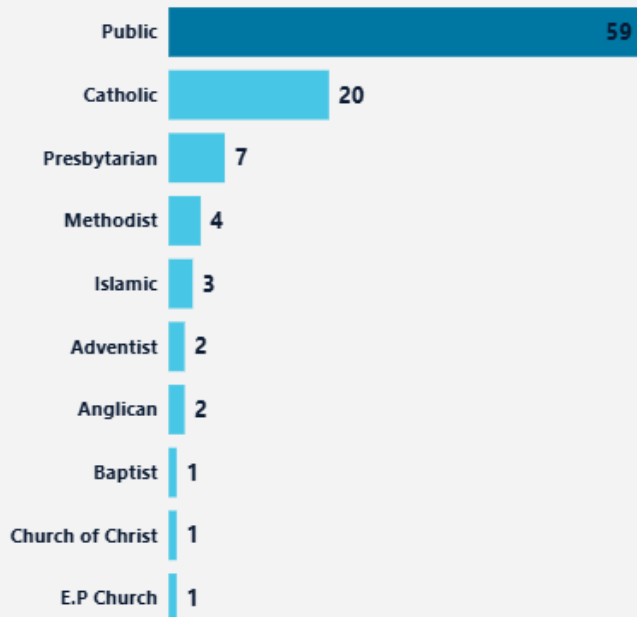
Top 5 Girls Schools



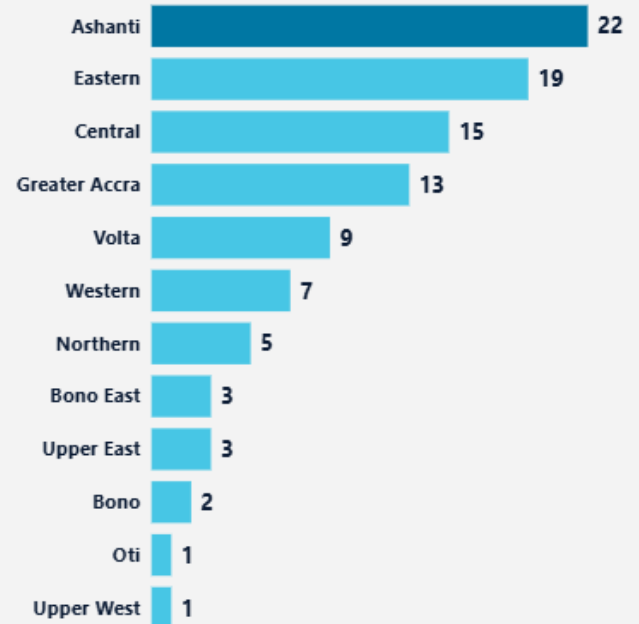
Winning by Affiliation



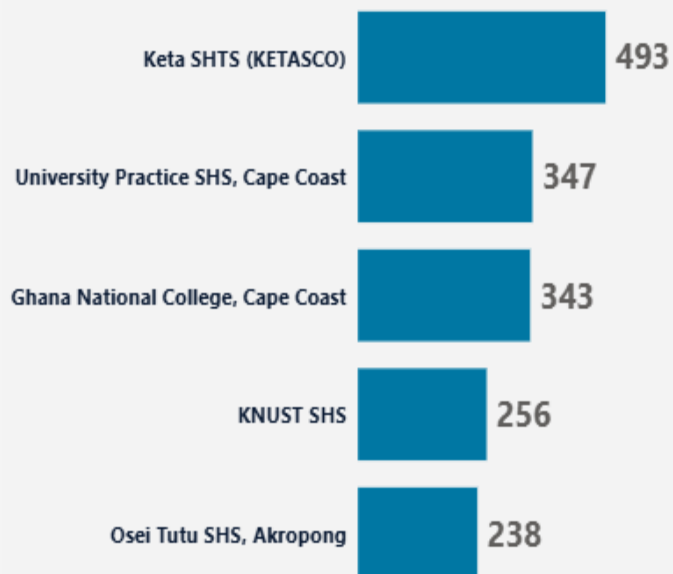
Top 100 Schools by Affiliation



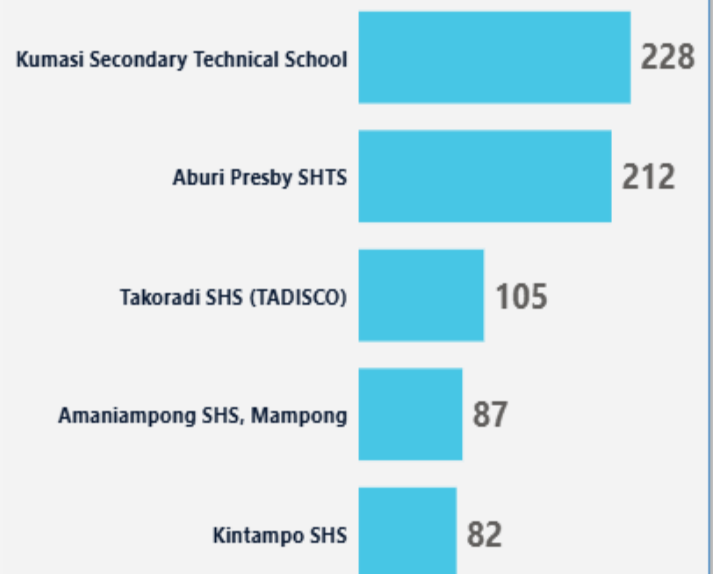
Regional Breakdown of Schools in Top 100



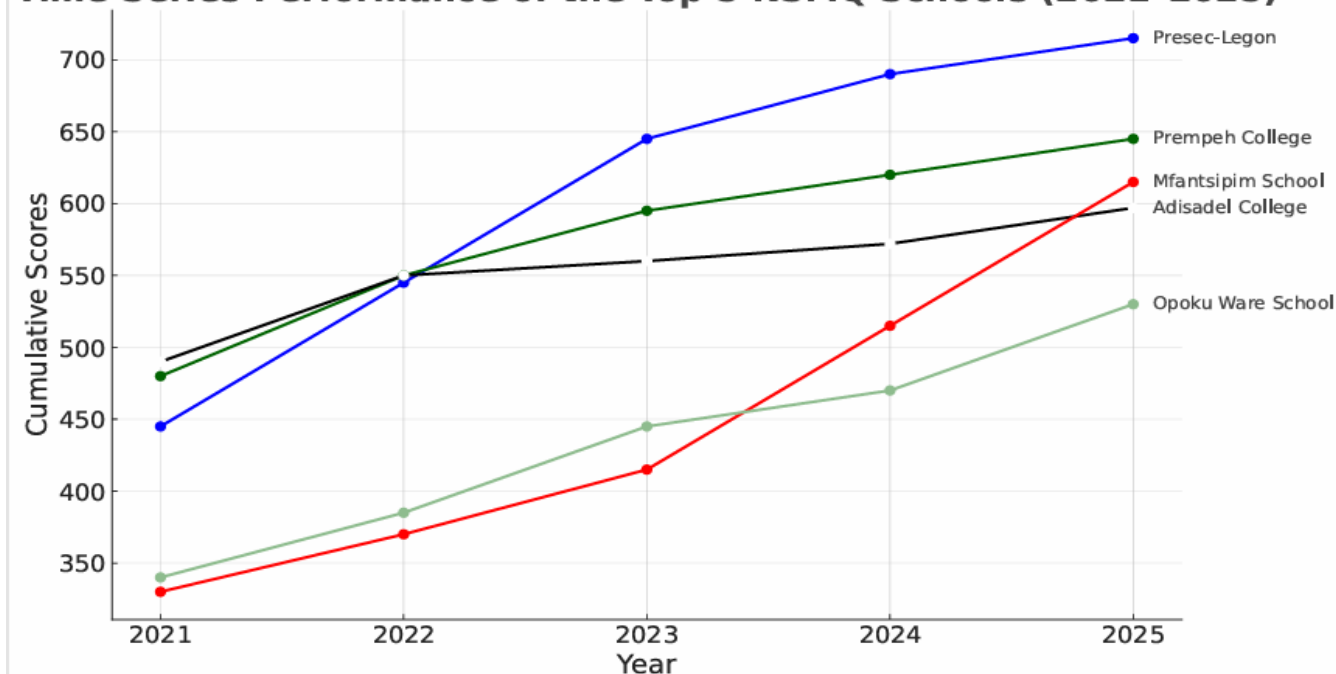
Top 5 Category B Schools

Top 10 Key Insights from the 2025 NSMQ Rankings

- [1]. **Mfantsipim School makes it back-to-back:** Mfantsipim School has once again written its name into the history of the National Science and Maths Quiz by becoming only the second school to win the competition in successive years. Replicating their impressive performance in 2024, Mfantsipim navigated a challenging field in 2025—surpassing Prempeh College and Adisadel College at the quarter-final stage, decisively defeating G.S.T.S. in the semi-finals, and ultimately overcoming St. Augustine’s College and Opoku Ware School in the grand finale to clinch the trophy.
- [2]. **Mfantsipim School Overtakes Adisadel College as the Top School in the Central Region :** Following their remarkable performance in the 2025 NSMQ, Mfantsipim School now holds the number one position in the Central Region, moving ahead of Adisadel College in the regional rankings.
- [3]. **Category C schools punch beyond their weight :** Two Category C schools, Amaniampong SHS and Mankranso SHS, both from the Ashanti Region, advanced to the semi-finals in the 2025 edition of the competition. This marks the first time in NSMQ history that two Category C schools have reached the semi-finals in the same year, showing that strong preparation and resolve can rival traditional powerhouses.
- [4]. **Presec –Legon tops rankings for three consecutive years:** Despite exiting at the quarterfinals stage in the 2025 edition, Presec–Legon maintained its position as the top-ranked school overall. Their consistently strong historical performance continues to keep them at the summit of the rankings.

- [5]. **Catholic, Presbyterian, Methodist, and Public Schools in a Deadlock** : The NSMQ rivalry is also fiercest along affiliation lines, as Catholic, Presbyterian, Methodist, and Public schools continue to battle for supremacy. Remarkably, each group has claimed the trophy three times within the last thirteen years, highlighting the rivalry not only among schools, but also among the major school affiliations in Ghana.
- [6]. **Biggest Climbers**: Mankranso SHS recorded the most remarkable climb in the 2025 rankings, rising 56 places—from 131st in 2024 to 75th in 2025. Amaniampong SHS followed closely, making an impressive 53-place leap from 115th position in 2024 to 62nd in 2025. The third most significant upward movement came from Mpraeso SHS, which advanced from 70th in 2024 to 53rd in 2025.
- [7]. **Top three Girls’ Schools**: Wesley Girls’ High School, Archbishop Porter Girls’ Secondary School, and St. Louis SHS remain the leading girls’ schools in 2025, occupying the first, second, and third positions respectively.
- [8]. **The top three Category B schools** for 2025 are Keta SHTS, University Practice SHS, and Ghana National College, respectively.
- [9]. **The top three Category C schools** in 2025 are Kumasi Secondary Technical School, Aburi Presby SHTS, and Takoradi SHS (TADISCO), respectively.
- [10]. The Ashanti Region continues to lead the rankings with 22 senior high schools featured in the Top 100, followed closely by the Eastern Region, which has 19 schools represented.

ABOUT THE EN ANALYTICS SHS RANKINGS FOR 2025

The Table is based on the performance of schools in the National Science and Math Quiz(NSMQ) since 2013. A school’s position on the log is determined by four key parameters: its final stage reached at the national level in the current year, its placement in the final contest it participated in the current year, the school category assigned by the Ghana Education Service, and its historical performance in the competition between 2013 and 2024. The points obtained are then exponentially smoothened to place more emphasis on recent year’s performance. A school’s position is not determined by this year’s performance alone. Instead, its position is a reflection of its cumulative performance over the last 13 years. Regional competitions do not count in determining the position of a school on the Table.

Apart from the national rankings, we have also produced regional rankings, which give opportunity to schools that are ranked outside the national top 100 to be featured in the regional rankings. A school that is neither in the national rankings nor the regional rankings is classified as “unranked”.

Ranking Methodology

The points a school gets in a particular year come from two main sources: competition points and category points. In this year's rankings, competition points account for 95.6% of total points while category points accounts for the remaining 4.4%

Competition Points

The Competition points a school gets in a particular year are based on the following rules:

- the **final stage** it reaches in the competition. The actual points a school gets in a particular contest do not count.
- its placement in the final contest it participated in the current year. For example, if two schools exit the competition at the quarter-final stage, the school that placed second will get higher competition points than the school that placed third.
- The competition points used in the ranking are **those assigned by the model**, not the points a school gets in a particular contest.
- If a school fails to qualify for the national competition for a particular year, it gets zero competition points for that year. However, its cumulative points would be retained on the ranking.
- Any school that did not qualify for the national competition in 2024 or 2025, or did not reach the One-Eighth stage at least once between 2013 and 2023 is not ranked either at the national level or at the regional level.

Category Points

A non-category A school may get additional points besides the competition points based on the category assigned to it by the Ghana Education Service (GES). A non-category A school must reach at least the quarter-final stage before it can earn Category Points. It is therefore not automatic. Category B, C, and F schools must prove their worth by reaching at least the Quarter Final stage before they are awarded category points. The model uses category points to re-scale the competition field to compensate for lack of science infrastructure in category B, C, and F schools. Below are how category points are awarded:

Dealing with ties

We have adopted the following conventions when ties occur:

- If two schools have the same points but one has won the competition before, or has won the competition more times than the other, then the one who has won the competition before or more times will be ranked ahead of the other even though they have the same points.
- If there is a tie and none has won the competition before, then they will be jointly ranked.

Why 2013 as the Starting Year

The current format of the NSMQ started in 2013. There was a complete evolution of the structure of the competition in 2013. First, the number of participating schools for each contest was increased from 2 to 3. Second, the number of schools at the One-Eighth stage was increased from 40 to the current 81.

PART B - REGIONAL RANKINGS

The region-specific rankings are aimed at making the rankings more meaningful to students, teachers and stakeholders in the regions. The regional rankings include the 160 schools that are in the EN Analytics rankings but could not make it into the top 100 in the national rankings.
